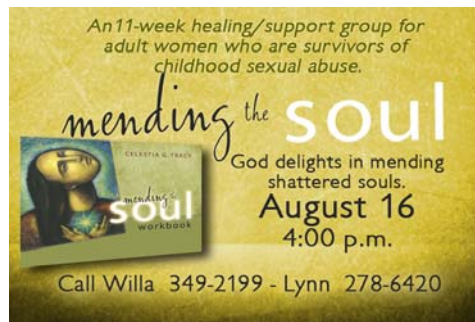
Has Do Something Become Done Something?

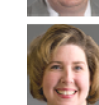

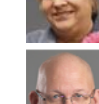

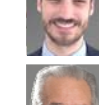
