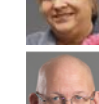

From Our Pastor

Welcome to First Baptist Church. If you are our guest, thank you for joining us today. We would love to be able to get to know you. Take a moment to register as a guest using the registration card attached to the bulletin. We invite you to bring this card to the Information Desk near the columns. We have a gift waiting for you there.



Today, I am continuing a series called "D-Up." These preaching topics are all focused on the Biblical call to discipleship. What is discipleship? In summary, discipleship is our call to be followers of Jesus Christ. Today, we are talking about a beginning act of discipleship—baptism. Even for those who have been baptized many years ago, I trust this morning will be a great reminder to you about your vow to Christ in baptism. For those who have not been baptized following your decision to believe in Jesus for eternal life, I pray today will be your day of decision to obey Christ through baptism.

Speaking of discipleship, our student ministry, under the direction of Student Pastor Brad Gill, has had their annual D-Now emphasis this weekend. Please pray this morning that every student who has participated will be a life-long disciple of Jesus.

I want to call your attention to the fact that this week is Sanctity of Human Life Week, marking the anniversary of the U.S. Supreme Court's *Roe V. Wade* decision legalizing abortion on demand in America. Southern Baptists are affiliated with some 250 crisis pregnancy centers scattered across the United States. Every time you give to the offering at First Baptist, a portion of it, through our denominational planned giving effort known as the Cooperative Program, is going to these Pro-Life Centers. Our Louisiana Baptist Children's Home has a mobile unit that travels the state. The unit is equipped with an ultrasound machine showing pregnant women, who might be contemplating abortion, the precious life inside of them.

Locally, there is a multi-denominational ministry called *A Pregnancy Center and Clinic*. The Clinic is located in the Medical Building at 913 S. College Road, Suite 206, Lafayette, LA 70503. The phone number is 232-5509. The LORD may want you to be involved in that ministry at some level. I have included their address in hopes you might send them a donation to support their ministry.
