Chorale Acadienne, the Acadiana Symphony Orchestra, and the First Baptist and Asbury United Methodist Choirs combine to present Jubilate Deo.

The performance is set for Friday, May 18, at 7:30 p.m., in the Worship Center of First Baptist Lafayette.

Dan Forrest's Jubilate Deo brings to life the global aspect of the traditional Psalm 100 text, "O be joyful in the Lord, all ye lands," by setting it in seven different languages and drawing from a wide spectrum of musical influences.
